Introduction

As part of CISAustralia's industry engagement strategy, we wanted to learn more about where each of our Australian University Partners are in terms of outbound mobility and what plans institutions have in place for the next 6 months when it comes to dealing with COVID-19.

A second survey will be sent later in the year to build on these results, analyse what has changed (if anything), and to benchmark institutional feedback. The aim will be to assist Universities in knowing what other institutions across Australia are doing or considering across mobility when it comes to COVID-19 planning.

In April 2020, CISAustralia developed a set of indicators for our partner universities to provide data to be shared anonymously and confidentially with those participating institutions. The results of this initiative may be used for the purpose of advancing shared knowledge across our partner institutions in regards to the impact of COVID-19 on outbound mobility.

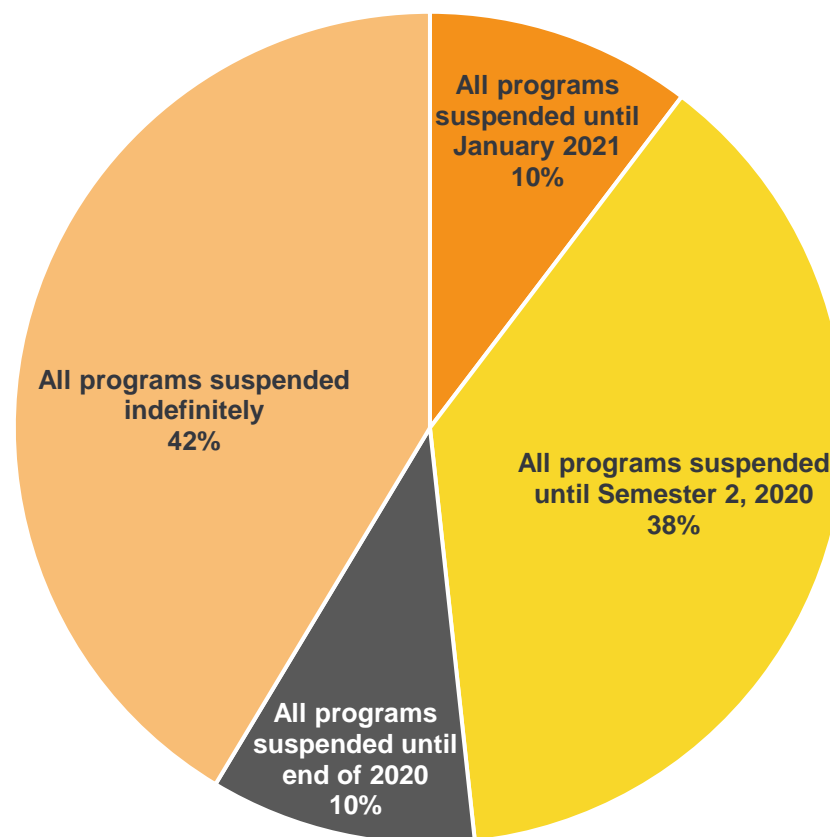

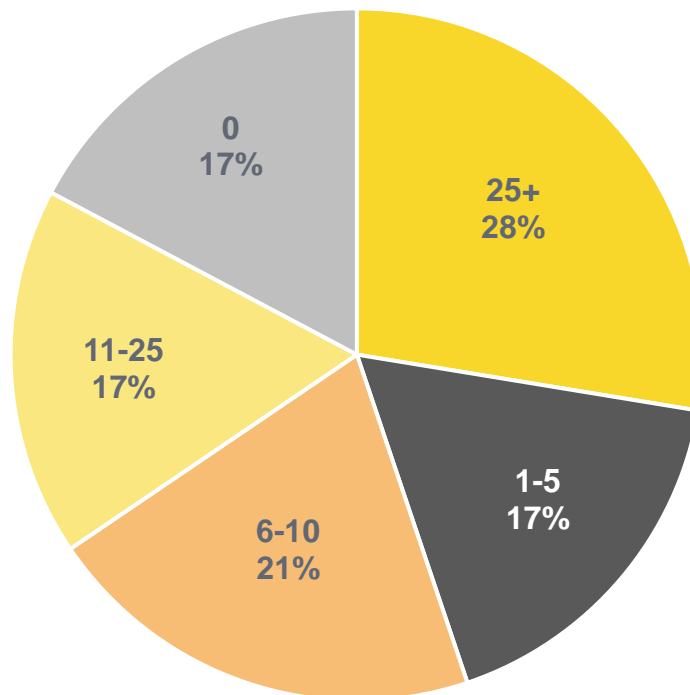


How has COVID-19 impacted your outbound mobility to date?



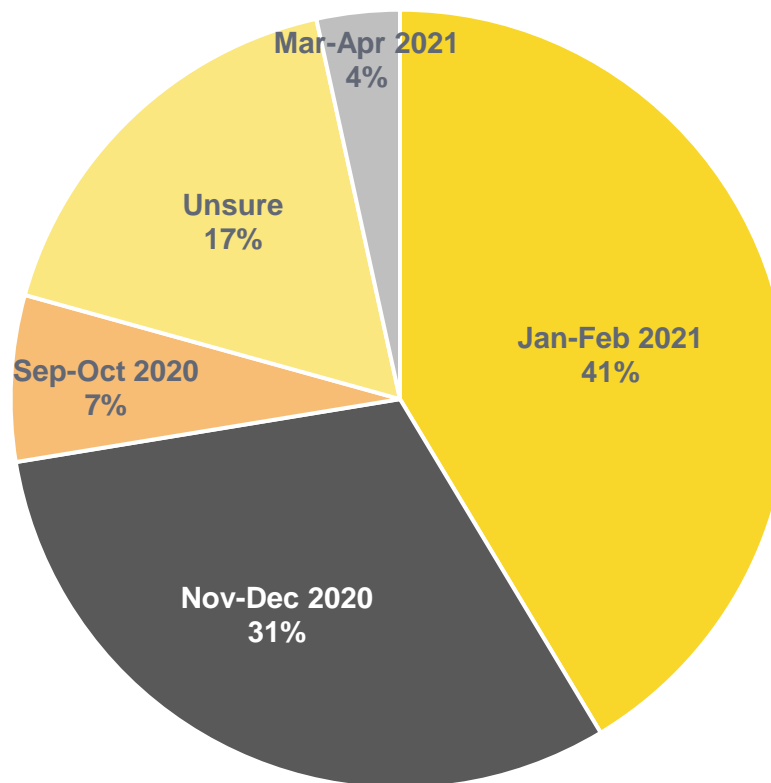

How many students do you currently have overseas from your University on an approved (for credit) study, intern, volunteer, exchange, or other program?



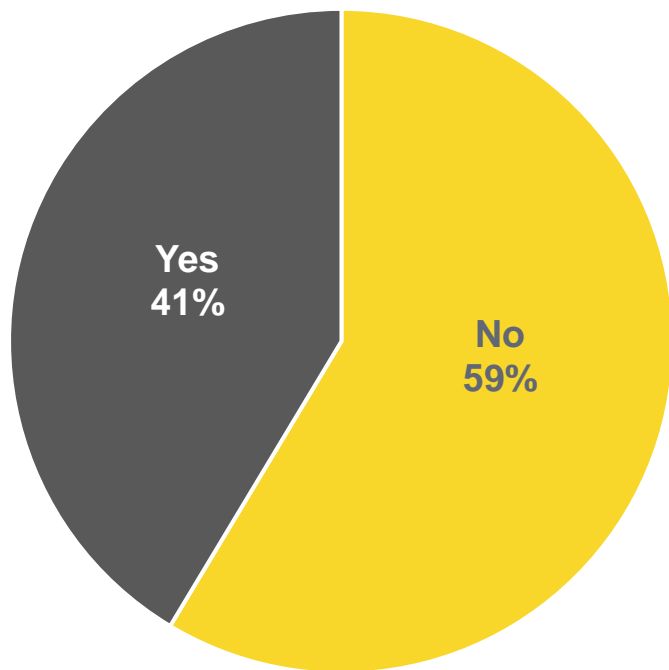

When are you expecting outbound student mobility to be approved again for students at your University?



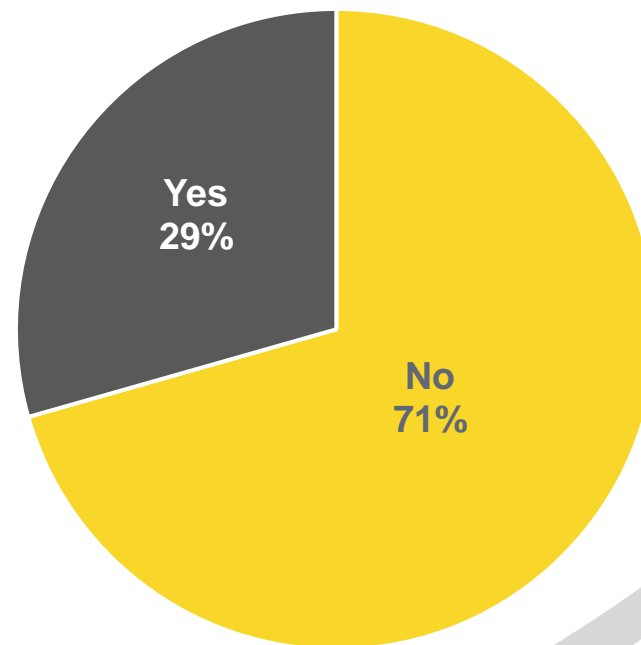

Do you plan to hold an on-campus (face to face) study abroad and exchange fair in the second half of 2020?



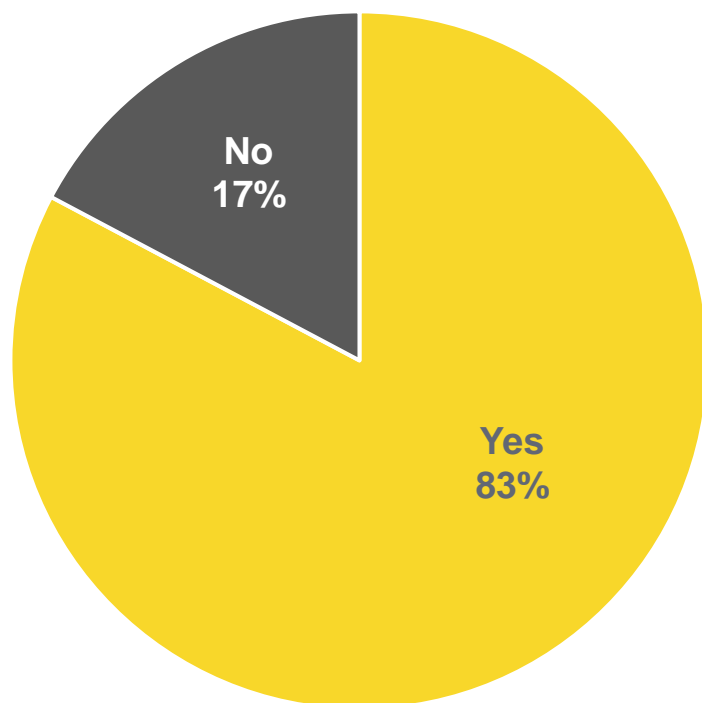

If no, are you planning to conduct an online alternative?



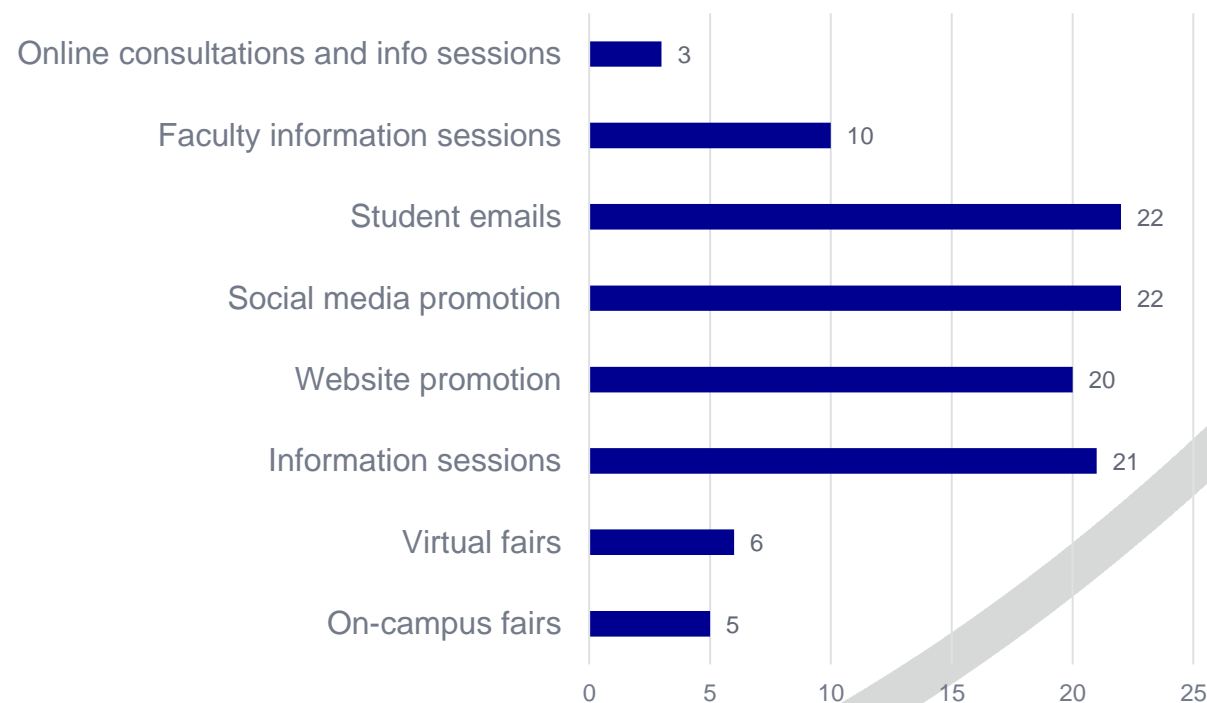

Are you planning any outbound promotion and/or promotional activities in the second half of 2020?



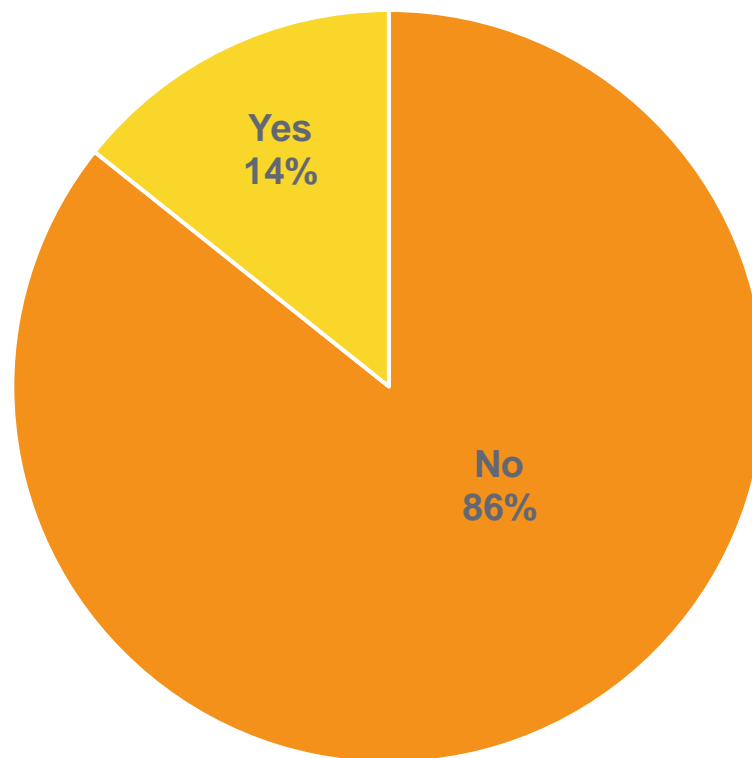

If yes, which outbound promotional activities do you plan to undertake in the second half of 2020?



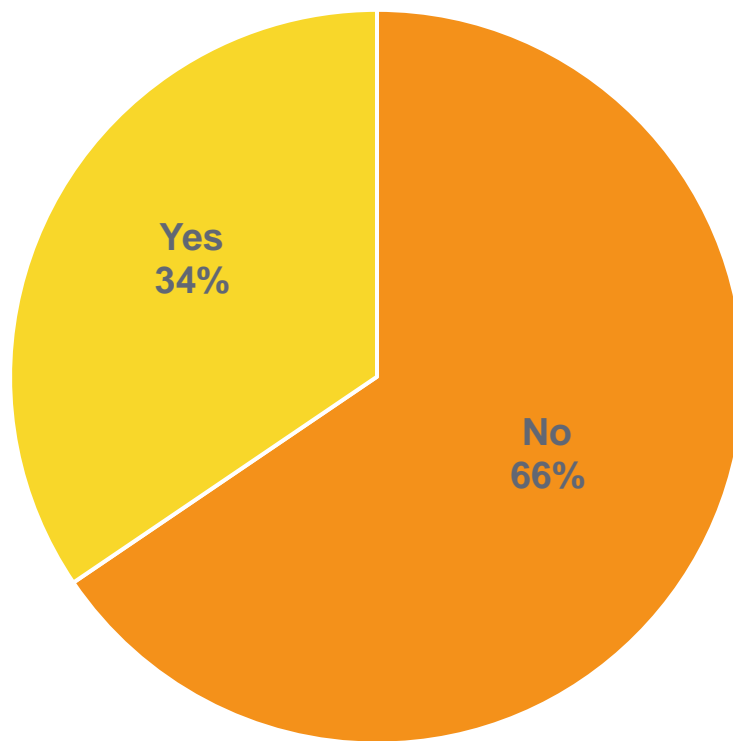

Has your study abroad and exchange (mobility) office been impacted by COVID-19 resulting in staff losses?



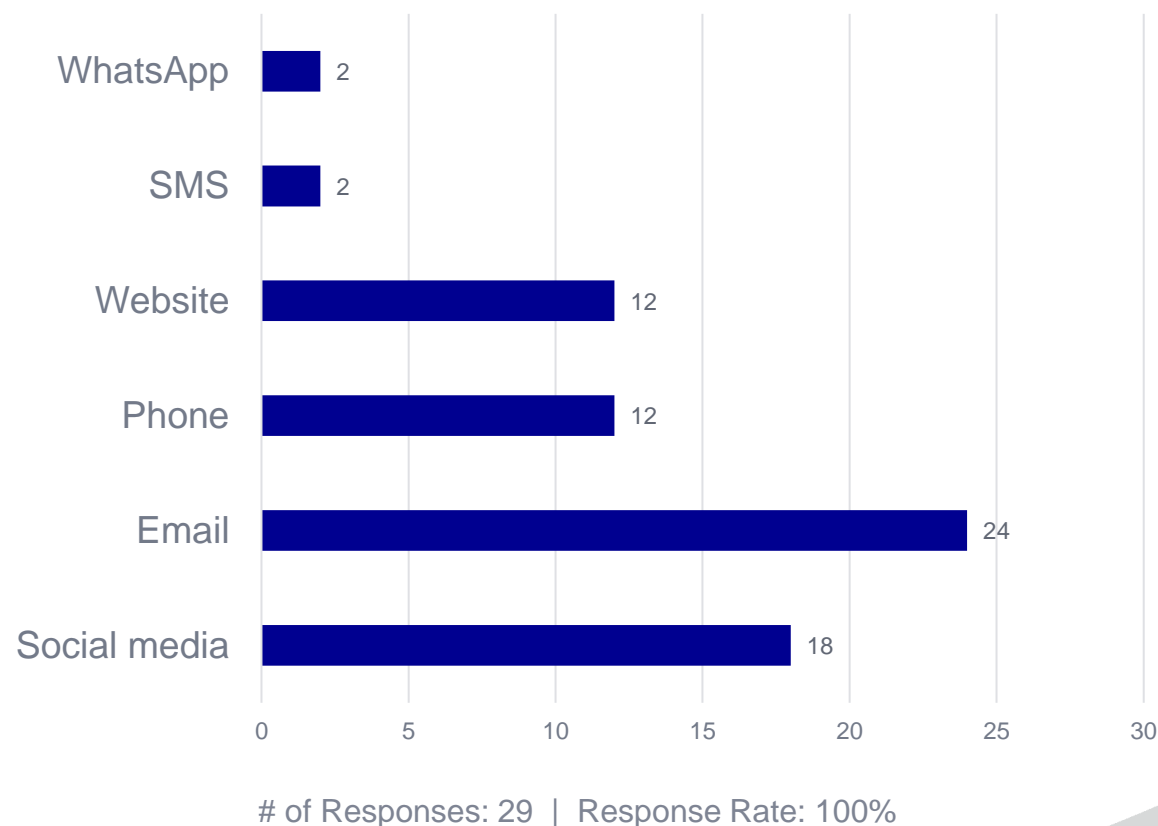

Has your study abroad and exchange (mobility) office been impacted by COVID-19 resulting in a loss of funding for outbound student mobility (beyond August 2020)?

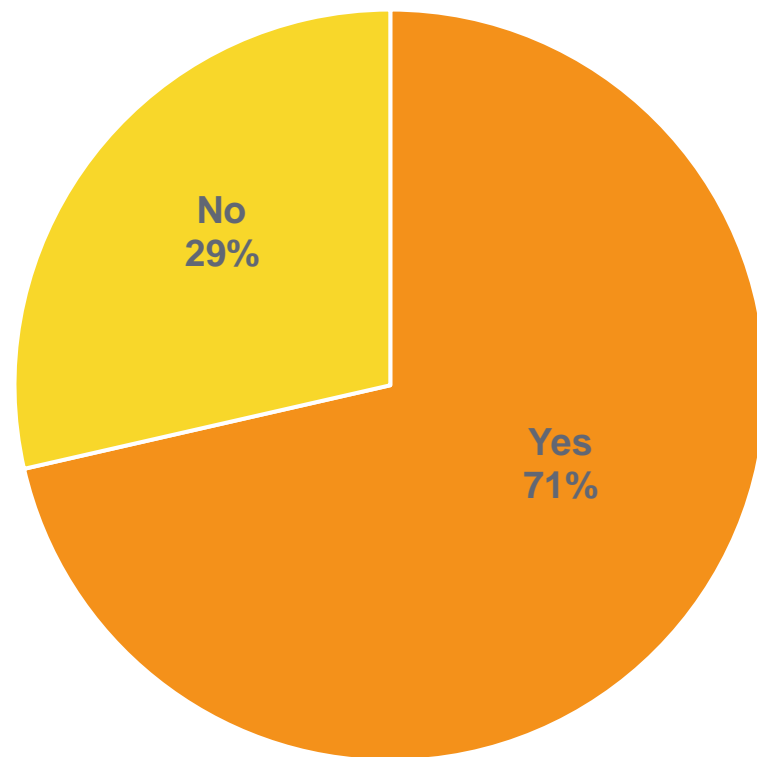
